Requirements: You must be an English major enrolled at the UW as an undergraduate for two quarters by the application deadline (March 16, 2018), **and** you must have a UW GPA of 3.5 and a UW English GPA of 3.7 with at least **10 credits of UW English course work completed**. During the term of the scholarship, recipients must be enrolled for at least two quarters and complete a minimum of 6 credits each quarter. Some scholarships require demonstrated financial need which will be certified by the UW Financial Aid Office.
